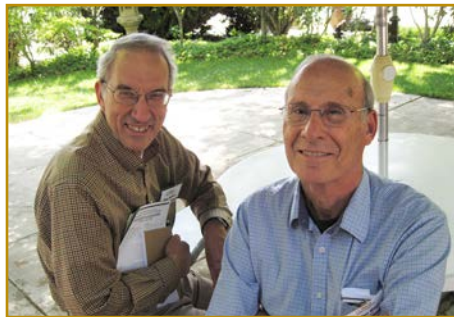

### About us

The UC Davis Emeriti Association (UCDEA) provides retired faculty from UC Davis, or other UC campuses living in the Davis area, opportunities for continuing interest in and support for the excellence of the University of California, Davis.

### Services and Programs

The UCDEA represents UC Davis emeriti/ae and provides the following services and programs for members:

- ⦿ **Advocates** for continued campus emeriti/ae benefits, including complimentary parking and lifetime library privileges
- ⦿ **Monitors** statewide or campus actions that relate to emeriti/ae welfare, such as pension, health care, and departmental privileges
- ⦿ **Plans** monthly educational noon talks and other programs jointly with the UC Davis Retirees' Association (UCDRA)
- ⦿ **Sponsors** three membership meetings per year
- ⦿ **Communicates** with members via a website and a members-only newsletter
- ⦿ **Supports** the UC Davis Retiree Center
- ⦿ **Recognizes** emeriti/ae with three annual awards—the Edward A. Dickson Award, the UC system-wide Panunzio Award, and the UC Davis Distinguished Emeritus/a Award
- ⦿ **Intercedes** on behalf of individual emeriti/ae with specific problems relating to retirement status or transition

### Organization

The UCDEA is governed by an executive board consisting of officers, several at-large members, committee chairs, and ex-officio members.

Committees include emeriti welfare, public relations, membership, program, newsletter and awards/recognition.

Members are encouraged to take an active role in the association by serving on a committee or running for a position on the executive board.



### Video Records Project

Since 1993, the UCDEA Video Records Project has been creating an oral history of the UC Davis campus by recording one-on-one interviews of emeriti/ae as well as others who have made significant contributions to the development of the university. More than 350 interviews have been recorded to date.

DVDs are given to both interviewers and interviewees. DVDs are shown regularly on DCTV and are available at Shields Library. All new emeriti/ae are encouraged to arrange for an interview.

### Eligibility

Any UC Davis retiree who has been granted emeritus/a status is eligible to join the UCDEA. The title of professor emeritus/a is conferred upon retirement on every professor and associate professor. In addition, the following retired faculty and staff may apply for emeritus/a status:

- ⦿ Academic appointees who are not members of the Academic Senate and who have at least 10 years of service, have attained the highest rank in their title series, and have evidence of noteworthy and meritorious contributions to the mission of the university.
- ⦿ Non-academic staff, Management and Senior Professional Grade III or above, or a position at any grade of the Senior Management Group, who have at least 10 years of service and have evidence of noteworthy and meritorious contributions to the mission of the university and to their professional field.

### Membership

Join the UCDEA today. The UCDEA is supported solely through dues and voluntary contributions. A strong and large association guarantees that emeriti/ae voices and concerns will be heard.

### Types of membership

- ⦿ Annual regular membership
- ⦿ Lifetime regular membership—available for a one-time fee; no renewals necessary
- ⦿ Associate membership—spouses of regular members and widows or widowers of deceased members do not pay dues.
