

Draft Minutes of the General Meeting of UCDEA, May 12, 2016, at the Buehler Center

After a brief social session, Vice-President Boorkman called the meeting to order at 2:14. She reviewed the activities of the UCDEA Executive Committee for the year, including coffee chats with campus administrators, the UC faculty survey, and the video records program, which now has a YouTube channel.

Bill Rains, chair of Awards and Recognition, announced that Isao Fujimoto had won the statewide Panunzio Award and listed many of Isao's accomplishments, including teaching many courses since his retirement, founding the Davis Co-Op and the Davis Farmers' Market, as well as protecting farmworkers' children from having to walk to school along Highway 99 by sending one of UCD's double-decker English buses to transport them.

Boorkman presented the slate of officers for UCDEA's Executive Committee for next year. The slate was moved, seconded, and passed without dissent. She then presented the by-law changes worked on this year. They, too, were moved, seconded, and passed without dissent.

The business meeting adjourned at 2:40, following which Program Chair Jim Shackelford introduced the speaker for the afternoon, Distinguished Emeritus winner Fred Block.
