term problem the associations had in receiving timely lists of the recently retired from the campus and/or the Office of the President. We made the breakthrough in obtaining these lists late this summer.


The committee also celebrated the success of our first major social event, the Steak Bake, held in June. We were so pleased that we have scheduled the event for next year on June 7, 2008. And, after exploring several options, we have supported the staff recommendations to sponsor two social events this fall. The first is an Open House immediately after the UC Davis convocation, which took place on September 26. The second is a Tailgate Party preceding the October 13 Aggie Football game. The Advisory Committee also has on-going discussions with the staff on two important events of the associations: the annual joint fall meeting on

health benefits on October 22 and the joint meeting of the system-wide equivalent organizations to UCDEA and UCDRA, CUCEA and CUCRA, which will meet on the Davis campus on October 25.

One task the Advisory Committee has to do without the assistance of our two capable staff is to elect the officers each June. Video Records Committee — John Goss

The Awards and Recognition Committee of the Emeriti Association recommended funding of the only proposal submitted for the Edward A. Dickson Award. Interim Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor Barbara Horwitz approved the recommendation of the Committee. The proposal was submitted by William Breidenbach, Prof. Emeritus, Agronomy; Alex McCalla, Prof. Emeritus, Agricultural Economics; and Verne Mendel, Prof. Emeritus, Animal Physiology for the Video Records Committee for the purpose of recording the oral histories of retired faculty. To date 317 oral histories have been recorded. These records are stored in Special Collections of Shields Library. The purpose of this proposal is to develop a historical collage of the UCD faculty from all of the colleges and schools of the Campus to be used by the Centennial Committee during the Centennial Year. Professor Emeritus Verne Mendel will be the Project leader and the 2007 holder of the Edward A. Dickson Emeriti Professorship.

On another note, recording activities have recently been curtailed due to flooding in the basement of Mrak. An air conditioning condenser ruptured, causing water damage in several rooms. Fortunately our room was not adversely affected, but we have not had access during the month of September. Video recording will resume in October.

OLLI Set For Fall Quarter

A Fall Quarter schedule full of fascinating classes has just been announced by the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI), under the aegis of UC Davis Extension. The OLLI program has evolved from the Davis Senior Learning Program (SLU) begun in 1997.

Course offerings include the literature of Beowulf, Geoffrey Chaucer, Noel Coward, Charles Dickens, and Henrik Ibsen. World War II is also a major focus, in coordination with the Ken Burns series on PBS. Successful aging, investment advice, French impressionism, and botanical mysteries promise to be stimulating and informative. All classes, costing from \$10 - \$40 each, are taught by experienced instructors, many of whom are experts in their fields.

For nostalgics, two courses dealing with "The Movies" will be featured: a centenary tribute to Laurence Olivier (free to OLLI members); and, in the downtown Varsity Theater, a six-week festival of Alfred Hitchcock's films, led by Davis Enterprise film critic, Derrick Bang.

Classes start October 1 and run weekly through November, and all (except the film programs) are held at the Davis Art Center. Membership in OLLI is \$10.00 per year. Please call (530) 757-8777 or (800) 752-0881 or go on-line at www.extension.edu/olli to obtain a schedule of courses.

December Luncheon Date Change



The UC Davis Distinguished Emeriti Award

The UC Davis Distinguished Emeriti Award honors outstanding scholarly work or service (e.g., service in professional, university, Academic Senate, emeriti, departmental, or editorial posts or committees) performed by a University of California, Davis emeritus or emerita since retirement.

Deans, the Provost, and the Emeriti Association may nominate individuals for the Award. Initial nominations may be made simply on the basis of a candidate's curriculum vitae and a nomination letter. The Awards and Recognition Committee will select one or more individuals for the development of a full dossier including a cover letter outlining the nominee's distinctive scholarly work and/or educational service since retirement, a copy of his or her curriculum vitae, and supporting letters from leaders in the field commenting specifically on the nominee's achievements since retirement.

Nominations should be submitted to the President of the UC Davis Emeriti Association by November 16, 2007. The nominations will be reviewed by the Awards and Recognition Committee and one or more candidates will be selected for development of a full dossier. The full dossier(s) will be forwarded to the Executive Committee for the selection of a potential recipient. The selected recipient will be endorsed by the Provost prior to making the award. The award will be announced by April 15, 2008.

The award will include recognition by his or her peers at an event such as the Chancellor's annual dinner for Emeriti, an appropriate memento, and/or a cash award of at least \$1,000.
